## IN TIME WITH GOD!

**Purpose:**  To know that God has given us time to accomplish His purpose...  And you can experience His Kingdom Life purposes as you stay in touch with Him!

**Scripture Verses:** Ecclesiastes 3:1 *"There is an appointed time for everything. And there is time for every event under heaven."*

**Overview:** In this Kingdom Life Study we are going to discuss the acronym for T.I.M.E., as follows:


T—Treasure or Trash

I—Industrious or Idle

M—Minister of Menace

E—Energize or Exhaust

**T – Treasure or Trash** – *What are you using your time to store up, treasure or trash?*

 Read Matthew 6:19-21. Look at verse 20. The idea is that you purposefully and consciously place your "treasures" in the eternal realm. People spend much of their time thinking and pondering on many things. Your thoughts are "stored" in your mind. From these thoughts, your "treasure or trash" is produced.

- **In the storage box of you mind, what will you find? Are they Treasure Thoughts, or Trash Thoughts?**
- **Read 2 Corinthians 10:5.** The latter part of this verse says that we are taking every thought captive (making it submit and bow) to the obedience of Christ.
- **Is this passive or proactive?**
- **How will this help you produce “treasure in heaven”?**

### **I - Industrious or Idle** - *Are you industrious, or are you idle?*


 Read Proverbs 19:15.

- **What comes from idleness?**

Sometimes people are idle because they have lost hope. It is important to renew your mind on the Truth contained in the Word of God, that you truly do have a future and a hope.


-  **Read Psalm 139:16. Do you believe God has a plan for your life? How can you know the plans God has for you?**

### **M - Minister or Menace** - *Are you a minister, or a menace, to your calling?*

 Read Romans 12:6-8. Learning to LISTEN to God, and to REALLY LISTEN with the intent to understand, is the only way you will know when, what, where, and how to use your gifts to help someone else benefit

- **What gifts has God given to you?**
- **How can you use them to build the Kingdom of God?**

### **E - Energized or Exhausted** - *Do you energize, or exhaust, those around you?*

 Read Romans 14:19. Peace is a powerful force. It is Christ in you, producing His Life in you and expressed as peace, that passes all understanding. Peace from God is in the mind, meaning we have peace of mind, or tranquility, that comes from KNOWING we have been reconciled to God.

- **What do you think is the difference between peacekeeping and peacemaking?**
- **How do you live in peace, when others are not at peace with you?**



**Kingdom Life Conclusion:** God has given us all the time we need. Are you using it in accordance with His appointed plans for your life? Determine today to use the valuable asset of God given TIME to build the Kingdom!
