FELLOWSHIP & PRAISE REPORTS:

Be sure to introduce any guest or first time attendees. Ask those attending to share a Praise Report of something good God has done during the week!

WORSHIP

JESUS CAME TO GIVE! By Gary Lanier

PURPOSE: To know that Jesus came to give, because He had something to give. Through His giving, He has enabled God's children to give. His is our example to follow.

SCRIPTURE VERSE: Luke 4:18-19

¹⁸The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised, ¹⁹To preach the acceptable year of the Lord.

OVERVIEW: Using the acronym **G - I - V - E** let's learn what Jesus gave to people, while He was here on earth.

Gospel Preached to the Poor. Jesus gave good news to the poor.

Read Matthew 9:35

- Share a few good news words that Jesus preached while on the earth?
- How has His good news affected your life?

Injured Hearts Healed. Jesus gave encouragement and healing to the broken hearted.

Read John 8:10-11

- How did Jesus give emotional healing to this woman?
- How have you experienced a heart healing from a tough situation?

Vision Recovered. Jesus gave sight to the blind.

Read John 9:10-11

- In order to see, what did the blind man do?
- What is another kind of sight, beyond physical sight?
- What is a way that Jesus gives insight today?

Emancipated the Captive & Crushed. Jesus gave freedom.

Read John 8:31-32, 34-36

- A person is captive to whatever holds him/her. What are some things that can cause bondage?
- What is the solution to bondage, according to the above scripture?
- What freedom are you experiencing, because of Jesus ?



KINGDOM LIFE CONCLUSION: The life of Jesus was one of giving and is *the* example to follow. Through His life, you have received life, and life more abundant! That's called Kingdom Life! Now it is your turn to give. Every believer is part of the Body of Christ, here on earth, and is called to give in the same way Jesus gave. Determine now to **G – I – V – E** the Jesus way!
