THREE TRIUMPHANT ENTRIES OF JESUS!

Purpose: To know that The Triumphs of Jesus are also ours to enjoy and experience.

Scripture Verses: *So the disciples went and did as Jesus commanded them. Matthew 21:6*

Overview: The key to allowing Jesus to triumphantly enter into our lives is found in the previous verse. Like so many other concepts in the Word of God, it is simple to grasp...they did as Jesus asked. The story of the Lord's triumphant entry into Jerusalem is found in Matthew 21:10-14. Look at the following three Triumphant Entries of Jesus and read the verses.

1. The Triumphant Entry into Jerusalem - Matthew 21:10-11

10 And when He had come into Jerusalem, all the city was moved, saying, "Who is this?" 11 So the multitudes said, "This is Jesus, the prophet from Nazareth of Galilee."

2. The Triumphant Entry into the Temple - Matthew 21:12-13

12 Then Jesus went into the temple of God and drove out all those who bought and sold in the temple, and overturned the tables of the moneychangers and the seats of those who sold doves. 13 And He said to them, "It is written, "My house shall be called a house of prayer," but you have made it a "den of thieves."

3. The Triumphant Entry into **Power** - Matthew 21:14

14 Then the blind and the lame came to Him in the temple, and He healed them.

Three Real Life Triumphant Entries for You!

1. The Triumphant **Jerusalem** Entry

The Triumphant JERUSALEM Entry is your ETERNAL LIFE! The multitudes said, "HOSANNA, HOSANNA, blessed is He who comes in the name of the LORD". HOSANNA, means SAVE. To experience the Jerusalem triumph, you must be born again.

- Can you share your salvation experience?
- Have you ever had the joy of sharing in someone else's salvation experience?

2. The Triumphant **Temple** Entry


The Triumphant TEMPLE Entry is your KINGDOM LIFE experience! The Bible says *Jesus in you, the hope of glory*. Your house, or body, is the house of God. It is your house of prayer. Sometimes we have to allow Jesus to clear out the stuff that gets in our temple! To experience the Temple triumph, you must fellowship with God in your house.

- Read Romans 12:1-2. What do these verses say about how we can allow the Lord to enter into our lives triumphantly?
- Can you think of specific ways, on a day-to-day basis, that the Lord asks to be triumphant in your temple?

3. Triumphant **Power** Entry

The Triumphant POWER Entry is your HOLY SPIRIT POWERED LIFE! The Bible says that you are the temple of the Holy Spirit. To experience the Power triumph you must be filled with the Holy Spirit. Read 1Cor.2: 12. The Spirit of God dwells in us to conform and change us into His image more and more everyday.

- What are some ways that the Holy Spirit can be made more welcome in your day-to-day life?
- How will this change your life for the better?

 **Kingdom Life Conclusion:** Life is too short not to obey our Heavenly Father and walk in His Spirit. There is nothing greater than our relationship with Him. Thank the Lord for giving His life to set you free. Thank the Lord for shedding His blood because He loves you. As you go, let all your entrances be triumphant, as you obey the Lord in all aspects of your life
